

Thank you, guys. It is good to have you back up here and singing again, as all the good people who do such a great job. If you have your Bibles, I want you to turn to John chapter 1, as you might have guessed. While you are doing that, Dale Light informed me this morning, as I was going back there after the announcement, that he is going to be preaching in Harrisonville this coming Saturday morning. We want to pray for him, so if you put that on your prayer list, remember that. We appreciate it.

I. The Concept of Biblical Separation

Now, last week, if you remember, we got into a great study out of our fifth section, and I told you how the first section of the Gospel of John in chapter 1 is basically an introduction to that Gospel. I have kind of broken it down into sections. Last week, we looked at our fifth section, and I am just trying to take it in pieces where everybody can—we do not try to swallow too much at one time, and we can get everything out of here that we really need to get.

From that section, we saw how the great concept of biblical separation, the Bible calls it sanctification, being set apart, and how we, as a model of Christ was to us, should be separated from the world. It is all based on [John 1:10] last week, where he was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. Of course, I took that and showed you how that is a great, great, great picture of where we should be in our walk through this life. The world should not be your friend, and you should not be part of the world system. When it comes to all the things of the world, and they look at you as a Christian, it should not know you. It may not like what it does know, but it does not know you in the sense that you are part of that system.

The Bible says that He came into this world, and He was totally separated from this world. I gave you a great verse that always comes to my mind in many, many, many situations in dealing with people, and it is the one found in [Amos 3:3].

Amos 3:3

Can two walk together, except they be agreed?

Of course, you cannot. Once you become a child of God, a child of light, you have nothing to do with the world of darkness anymore, and the two cannot walk together unless you give up the light. When you got saved, you are supposed to give up the darkness and embrace the light. But what happens many times is that God's people give up the light and embrace the darkness, and that is where the problem comes in.

Then the Bible says that He came unto His own, and His own received Him not. I took some time with that because I think this is a very important aspect that we all need to see how He was, when Jesus came to this earth at the first coming of Christ, we know that He was born of a woman. The Catholic Church teaches that Mary was a perpetual virgin. That means that she never had any more children. Of course, that is not true. Those kids are listed. His brothers and sisters are listed in the New Testament, and there were more children that she had other than

Him. But it also tells us that His own brothers and sisters, outside of James, the Lord's brother, rejected who He was. He got separated from His own family.

I told you last week that unfortunately, that is what happened. That is a great model in the Bible. I would think it would be a great comfort in the Bible for someone who finds themselves in that situation with your own family, because it does happen. [Luke 12:51-53], Jesus Himself said,

Luke 12:51-53

Suppose ye that I am come to give peace on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division:

For from henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three.

The father shall be divided against the son, and the son against the father; the mother against the daughter, and the daughter against the mother; the mother in law against her daughter in law, and the daughter in law against her mother in law.

You suppose that I come to give peace on earth? That is what we always hear. At Christmas time, you will see every Christmas card, every front yard and everything there, peace on earth, good will toward men. That is the way the world supposes that Christ came for. Of course, He says, "I tell you, but rather division." Now that goes against everything that the evangelical world and certainly the mishmash Christian world preaches today, that we live in a world in Christianity where everybody is trying to get together. The Bible clearly says that Jesus did not come to put everybody together. He came to divide folks. He divides them over the book that you are holding in your hand today.

He said, "From henceforth there shall be five in one house divided, three against two, and two against three. The father shall be divided against the son, the son against the father, the mother against the daughter," what outlined that one, "the mother against the daughter and the daughter against the mother, the mother-in-law against her daughter-in-law." Of course, mother-in-laws are against everybody, so that does not really matter. "The mother-in-law against the daughter-in-law and the daughter-in-law against the mother-in-law." This is a pure case where the in-laws become the outlaws, and you can deal with that all the time. These are separated because of the Word of God. The Word of God will divide you from your own family. I have seen it all in my ministry. I have dealt with situations where it has happened. It is simply because the greatest single aspect of the Word of God, before anything else, is that it divides.

He divided the light from darkness in [Genesis 1:4]. [Hebrews 4] says, when you get saved, He divides you from the flesh to your soul. After you are saved, then He separates you and divides you from the world. Sometimes that will even affect your family. Somebody said one time to a young lady, "What justification do you have for separating yourself from your family?" The answer would be the same justification that Jesus had. Let me be clear here: Jesus did not leave them. They left Him. It was not the fact that He got up one morning and said, "I do not want to be part of this family anymore." It was the morning the family got up and said, "We do not want you part of our family anymore." It was because of what He represented.

There are going to be times in your life, and you need to take comfort in this. There are going to be times in your life, and I know it is tough, it is not easy, but there are going to be times in your life when you stand for the truth. It is going to cost you something in your own family. It is just that simple. They left Him. He did not leave them. The book divided them. You are going to find, it has been true in my ministry, you are going to find that people come to this church or any other church, and then they get their nose bent in a joint over something that is ridiculous, and then they are going to leave, and they want you, as their son or their daughter, to leave with them to support their ungodliness. You have enough character and enough sense that you say, "I am not going to do that." It is going to cause you some problems.

Of course, the problem is simple. It is always simple. Jesus was doing God's work, and His family, as far as His brothers and sisters, did not want anything to do with it. In fact, the Bible says that they were offended by it. When you get into a Bible-believing church, whether it is this one or some other one, whatever the case may be, there are going to be people who had a shot at the truth and did not take it, and because you stayed with it, are going to be offended by it. They are going to be offended by your stand. I do not know what to tell you about that, other than the fact that, praise the Lord. If you do not stand for something, then you will fall for everything. That is what it takes no time. So they left Him. Put it into a New Testament context. They left the book, they left the church, they left God, and He did not. That is going to cause you some problems.

How easy was that? We like to make things so complicated, like there are real issues and there are real problems. No, most of the time there are not. Most of the time you have people who no longer want to follow the Bible. When you take your stand to be on God's side, it is most definitely going to separate you because it is going to cost you something. That is just the way that it works.

Then we saw, not only was that His own flesh and blood, His family did not receive Him, but also it says He came unto His own, and that is His physical family, but it is also His brethren, the nation of Israel. The nation of Israel did not want to know who He was anymore. They just like moms and dads, just like our verse there in Luke. They did not want to know anything more about Him, and they did not care to have anything to do with Him. Just like, I have always said that Jesus is the only man who never hurt anybody in His life, who never did anything bad to anybody, who only came to help everybody, but a whole world wanted nothing to do with Him. That is a great principle because at the end of the day, when you get separated from whoever, I can guarantee you it is going to be your fault because they never take responsibility for anything. They always have to blame somebody else for their issues. That is what Israel is doing here.

Israel is in the sorriest state that you have ever seen in your life, just like a lot of God's people in their families. They are in the worst spiritual condition they could ever be in. God sends them somebody with the truth, and they do not want it. They wind up crucifying it because they labeled Him as the problem for their nation, and you will get labeled as the problem for the family. Enjoy it, make friends with it, because that is just the way that it is going to be.

His brethren Israel in [Matthew 12] and [Matthew 13], these two key chapters in Christ coming to His brethren really show us what the problem was because it is in these two chapters where the nation of Israel made their official rejection through the scribes, the Pharisees, and the Sadducees. We talked about them last week, how the scribes who were biblical were completely corrupted, and the Sadducees and the Pharisees who are not biblical had taken over the nation of Israel. They are the ones who pushed for the official rejection of the Lord Jesus Christ. Yet the Bible says that the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us.

America made its choice. The only thing men ever learned from history is the fact that they never learned anything from Israel. Israel made their choice way back in [Matthew 12] and [Matthew 13] when they rejected Christ in the truth, and America made their official rejection in 1888 down in Sarasota, Florida, where the Southern Baptist Convention dumped the King James Bible on that great convention and officially adopted the RSV of 1888. Incredible parallels.

II. The Word Was Made Flesh

Now, having said that, today we want to look at another section, and we are going to actually bolt all these sections together. But we have to look at them, examine them. It is easier to look at one piece at a time, and then you can put it all back together again. That is the way I have done my Bible. That is the way I do most things in life. I have found for me, and maybe for you, it is a good way to do it.

Now look at another incredibly important verse here. We are not going to get past this one today.

John 1:14

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

For our learning experience today, that is what they tell you in the world, for our learning experience today, this is some really good material in this verse that we want to look at. So let us have a word of prayer, and then we are going to jump right into it and work through this thing today in [John 1:14].

Our Father, we thank You and praise You for the Lord Jesus. We love You, thank You for all You do for us. Pray Father Your blessings upon our time today. Take what we have learned last week and the weeks before that and the weeks before that and add it to what we learned today that we may put this great book into a context of our life that will really help us and show us what we need to see. We will be careful to give You the honor and the praise in Jesus' name for the sake we ask it, amen.

Now I am a divider when it comes to things in the Bible. I have found in my own life that that is the best way to learn it. So I have divided today's message, and I do this a lot, I do not always say it, but I have divided today's verse into four concepts. To me, that is easier to understand than just taking the whole answer a lot and trying to stuff it down your throat. I want to show you some things here, and we have to do it in sections.

The first thing I want to look at is in that verse, [John 1:14], it says, "And the Word was made flesh." I want to talk about that for you in a few moments, and right here, without going any farther, we have the issue of our day. We have the issue of Christianity today, and I think that it needs to be addressed, and it certainly needs to be answered. The question is today, do we have the very Word of God?

You know, in church history, we know from [Revelation 1-3] that there were seven periods of church history. I have told you when we come through church history that each period of church history had to deal with a doctrinal issue, something that they, the church, the true church of Jesus Christ, some heresy that came up that they had to confront and keep from taking over and penetrating into the church and defend the Bible against it. Every, every period of church history. For you and for me, from 1900 on, it has been the issue of the Word of God. Do you have the absolute perfect, inspired Word of God today? Was Christ the incarnate Word at the first coming, or was He not? Does the verse mean what it says when it says that the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us? Is that true?

If it is true, when He then goes back to heaven in [Acts 1], does He take the book with Him and leave it or leave it here? If He takes it with Him, then He basically says to the church for the next 2,000 years, "You figure it out. Let man give you the best rendition of My life and what I want to do through your life that he can. I am out. I am going back to heaven, and I am taking the book with Me. And you guys are left to figure it out on your own." In other words, can you have the very Word of God today as perfect as He is without sin or any error in it?

Now we know, and there would be no argument, when Jesus came, He was sinless. Your salvation depends on that. The Bible says He became sin for you, but He was a perfect man and without any sin on Himself. Then God put our sin on Him. Now we all would agree with that. The problem is, do we now believe that the very God who gave us a sinless Savior could give us a sinless Bible? Okay, that is the problem. That is the problem. If it is available, where is it? How do I get my hands on it?

Now 99.9999999%, you say, "Why do I always say that?" Because the guy told me one time that it just drove him up the wall, and he left the church because I always said it that way. So I am doing that in your honor. 99.9999999999999999% of the power that we have, pastors, Bible teachers, Bible colleges, will tell you that you cannot have it. We were told in [John 1:1] that,

John 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Now that is either true or not. I believe it is true. Now we are told in [John 1:14] that that same Word that was one with God has now come down and been manifested in the flesh. If we take that at face value, then Jesus Christ was the living, perfect example of the Word of God because in heaven, the Word of God is settled. [Psalms 119:89]. It is settled in the fact that it is one with God, and when God sent His Son down here to this earth, He simply took the Word of God that was settled in heaven and manifested His Son through it. When Christ showed up, you have the incarnate Word of God. [1 Timothy 3:16] says,

1 Timothy 3:16

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

No controversy about it. He says without controversy, God was manifested in the flesh. Now in the Bible, you have a key word. That key word will be the word "translation" or "translate." You say that is two, well it is the same word I just used in a two different way, same word. You will find that those two words are only found five times in your Bible.

Now here is the key. The world, Bible scholars, our own version of the scribes, Pharisees, and the Sadducees today will tell you that the word "translate" or "translation" will mean from one language to another. That would be true. You have a King James Bible in Spanish called the Valera. You have a translation in German called Martin Luther. So it is true in a worldly academic sense that when you translate something in this world, you will go from one language to another.

Now here is the key. In the Bible, it does not mean that. This is why I try to tell you over and over and over again, the Bible defines itself. We sell Noah Webster's dictionary back there in the back, and it is a fine dictionary, and I recommend it. But I am going to tell you over and above that, the greatest dictionary of how God uses words is the Bible you have in your hand today. You see, the world scholarship, your pastors, Christianity will tell you that the word "translation" or "translate" means one language to another. But in the Bible, that is not true. This is the key, how you can know today that if you have a King James 1611 Authorized Version, you have the very words of God that are perfect, that are inspired, that have been preserved and were out proven error. You do have the Word of God based on the word "translate" or "translation." Because in the Bible, the word "translate" or "translation," here it comes, is never used in the form of one language from another. It is always used one place to another, never a language.

In [Hebrews 11:5], you find the word used three times.

Hebrews 11:5

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

That has nothing to do with languages. That is dealing with Enoch going from here to where God was. God told you three times that he was translated. Three times He tells you that translation in that verse is not language to language, but one place to another.

Then in [2 Samuel 3:9-10], it says this:

2 Samuel 3:9-10

So do God to Abner, and more also, except as the LORD hath sworn to David, even so I do to him;

To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

No languages involved. Here it is the kingdom of heaven is being translated from the house of Saul, one place, to the house of David, another place, no languages involved at all. My, my, my, you would think that somebody that claims to know the Bible, that someone that works in a Bible college or works in a church and teaches people all week long and every Sunday would just know a little bit about the Bible. The word "translate" or "translation" never deals with one language to another. It deals with one place from another.

Look at [Colossians 1:13]. It says,

Colossians 1:13

Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

Talking about Christ, "who hath delivered us from the power of darkness and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son." No languages involved there. You were translated from the world in darkness to His Son in light. You went from the power of darkness, and you were translated into the kingdom of His dear Son. Now, if you do not know what that kingdom is, that is your salvation. It is salvation. [John 8:44] says,

John 8:44

Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Before salvation, you were in that family, and that family was darkness. When you got saved, He took you out of that family, and He translated you into the kingdom of His dear Son. That is the kingdom of God. [Romans 14:17] says that that is a spiritual kingdom. [Luke 17:21] says that that spiritual kingdom of God is inside you right now today. That is [Colossians 1]. That is the spiritual circumcision. That is your soul becoming one with God's Spirit at the day you got saved, and God used no language to do that. He translated you from the world into the kingdom of His dear Son. He just moved you, He just translated you from one family to another. Because in the Bible, the word "translation," "translate" never is about languages.

Now you see the importance of allowing the Bible to be your true dictionary. It defines not only everything, but it defines everybody. Translation or translate never is one language from another in the Bible, but always from one place to another. That sets up one of the greatest studies and the greatest keys that you know you have the Bible, you have is the King James Bible.

Now here it comes, that at the first coming of Christ, the Word of God was translated from God. It is settled in heaven. It is translated from God who was God and was with God. Down to the Word was made flesh, and Jesus Christ went from heaven, one place, to earth, and He was translated from heaven to earth and became the incarnate Word of God. The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us. You see, people get so hung up on languages because you hide behind

languages because you can propagate your lie about translations in the Bible because you hide behind the world's definition of translation or translate. But when you get into the Bible and you see how God uses it, at the first coming of Christ, the Word of God was translated from God, heaven, down to earth, and the Word became flesh, and it was manifested, and the Word became flesh.

Now, when Christ goes back to heaven in [Acts 1], He did not leave us without a Bible. He did not leave us without a Bible. He did not leave us without truth. He did not take it back to heaven with Him. This time He translated it from His Son into a book, which the Bible says is His mind. His body went back, but His mind stayed, and He translated Jesus Christ into a book, one place to another. So you and I could know Him, [Philippians 2:10], the book of [1 John]. So the Bible now in the church age tells us after that transition takes place, it says in [Philippians 2:5] that we have the mind of Christ.

Philippians 2:5

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:

You know why? Because when Christ's body went back to heaven and God translated Him back up there, He translated it not the incarnate Word, but now the written Word. That is why you have a Bible, and the Bible says that Bible is the mind of Christ, and you are to let that mind be in you, which was, here it comes, also in Christ Jesus. God translated His body back to heaven, but He translated His mind into a book and gave it to you and me.

Then He says in [1 Corinthians 2:16],

1 Corinthians 2:16

For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? But we have the mind of Christ.

He says, "Who hath known the mind of the Lord that he may instruct him?" That is a good question. How would you find the instruction of God if you do not know what God wants you to do? Are you going to rely on a man telling you what God wants you to do? Are you going to rely on God telling you? How is He going to tell you? How are you going to know what is on God's mind for your life unless you have that mind? When God took His Son back to heaven, He translated Him from this life up. When He came down, it was the Word of God translated from heaven down here. When He took it back up and translated, it was the fact that He translated in one place to the other the written Word of God that you have in your hand right now. "Who hath known the mind of the Lord that we may instruct him, but we, we, we, we have the mind of Christ." You have it right now.

If that was not enough, [1 Peter 4:1] tells you and me that we are to arm ourselves with this same mind.

1 Peter 4:1

Forasmuch then as Christ hath suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves likewise with the same mind: for he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin;

That is the same mind that was perfect in Christ. That is the same mind that was complete in Christ when He was here, that Christ had at the first coming of Christ, and when God took Him back to heaven, He translated it to you and me, His mind. The Word was God manifested in the flesh and now manifested or transitioned into a perfect book, the mind of Christ. That perfect book is the King James 1611 Authorized Version. It is just that simple. It is perfect, it is complete, it is inspired, it is preserved, Word of God.

Now you see how easy that was? The Bible always makes it simple. It is man who wants to tell you, you have to spend 20, 30 years and \$200,000 to study two dead languages that nobody speaks anymore and figure out your Bible. That is what man does to you. God put it down into third and fourth grade English. His Holy Spirit of God enveloped that book and gave us everything the way He wants, and it contains everything that we need.

Let me pause here for a moment and show you the other side for the record. When you get into churches today, the neo-evangelical maniacs, most Baptist idiots, when you get into most Christians who teach the Bible today, the standard teaching will be, and just listen to me carefully. In fact, do not even take any notes on this. This is so absolutely incredibly stupid that you do not want to miss this. Because when I am done, you are going to think how absolutely absurd all of this is. I have been in this business for almost 50 years. I have seen it all. I have heard them all. I have talked to them all. I know exactly what they teach and why they believe it, and that is the basis for why I believe what I believe.

Here is, for the record, here is the standard teaching. They will tell you in Bible colleges, most pastors in most churches, that the Bible is the inspired and perfect Word of God in the original autographs. All we have today will be a translation, King James Bible translation, New American Standard, RSV, NIV. Those are translations. The reason why since 1900, up to where we are at today, you have had over what, 300 new translations? Every year they come out with a couple more is because scholarship, our scribes, Pharisees, and Sadducees of our day do not believe that any Bible is perfect but only a translation. So they keep upgrading it based on the Greek and the Hebrew that only they know to give you a more accurate Bible that yet it may be closer to the originals. It may have more truth than the last one, but it will still not be perfect because the only perfect Word of God is in the original autographs. That is their position.

They will tell you that you have to go back to the Greek and the Hebrew, get those Greek little nuggets of gold out of there in Hebrew that will explain the Word of God to you and make it so much clearer. Because none of you saps can do that, first rule of public speaking, never speak down to your audience. Some of you idiots do not get that, but I am telling you. Because you and I cannot do that, we have to go to them. Very subtly, very quietly, with all the meekness and humbleness of the demonic spirits in the lake of fire, they take the place of the Holy Spirit of God to your life. No more do you get on your knees and ask God to open up the scriptures to you. Now you just go to your Greek and Hebrew lexicon, and when you cannot figure it out, you go to your scribe, your Pharisee, your Sadducees, and he will tell you what the verse means.

Some of God's people are okay with that. I am not. I believe the Bible was given to the common man in a common Bible that anybody on this planet could figure out the Bible, and you do not need a college education in a Bible college or Greek and Hebrew to figure it out. In fact, that will be a determinant. Now we saw an example of this, and a dear lady called a question in a couple of Thursday nights ago about some ridiculous Bible study where somebody was teaching the word "love" based on the two Greek words, *phileo* and *agape*, and how those Greek nuggets really told you what kind of love that that was. When you read this verse, was it *phileo* love or *agape* love? One of them is a common like, "I love you, yeah, you are my friend." The other one is, "I love you." Supposedly from this pretense of a Bible study, you can now go to your Bible, and you can look up the Greek words, and you would know what kind of love that was. Of course, when you really investigate it in the Bible, and I hate to say that because when you study the Bible, you find out this goofy stuff is not true, you will find that God never uses the words that way. He uses them interchangeably. Any way He wants to, and *agape* and *phileo* mean, listen to me, absolutely nothing. The fact that Greek and Hebrew is a necessity for you figuring out the Bible is the greatest, without a doubt, the greatest lie that everyone has hatched out of the depth of hell.

Here is the false teaching in all of this. Bible scholars, Bible colleges, Greek scholars, Hebrew scholars will be, and I do not even know how to say this in a nice way, and I am not even trying to. They are some of the most demonic, satanic implants that you will ever find in Christianity. Before you raise the roof with that, go back in history, just like the demonic, Sadducees, Pharisees, and the scribes of Jesus' time.

Now, here is the deal. You want the facts? All right, here comes the card face up. The originals, really? Years ago, there was a preacher preaching, and he did not believe the King James Bible was the Word of God. He was a good preacher, and he is preaching from the pulpit, and he got preaching on something that led to the Bible. He is waving, and he was preaching out of a King James Bible, and he is waving it back and forth saying, "We believe the Bible is the plenary inspired, absolute perfect Word of God, and you can rest your soul on it." Everybody in the place went crazy, and amen. Well, it got my attention. Shortly after that message was over, I met him in the hallway, and I said, "Well, praise the Lord, brother. I said, you finally have come to the place where you believe the King James Bible is the absolute perfect Word of God." He says, "Well, certainly not." I said, "You were waving it up there saying this." He said, "Well, I was talking about the original autographs." I said, "Now I know your shoes are black, but Buster Brown, is not that just a little deceptive? That you are getting up there, not believing that the Bible is the absolute perfect Word of God, but you are waving it back and forth telling the people out there," and he says, "Well, they know the difference." I thought to myself, "You know what?" I said, "Then I got a question for it." I learned some things. I learned that these guys, I mean, these guys are as crooked as a dog's hind leg. These guys, when they get up in the morning, they are so crooked, they have to screw their socks on. I mean, it is unbelievable.

I said to him, I said, "Well, let me ask you a question. Does not the word 'Bible' mean books?" And he said, "Yes, it does." And I said, "So the 66 books of the Bible make it a Bible. Correct?" "Yes, that is correct." I said, "Well, let me ask you something. In history, whenever, were all the

original manuscripts in one book?" They were not. Nobody in the history of the world has had, if the original autographs are the inspired Word of God, and they are your perfect Bible, there was never a time in the history of the world in almost 6,000 years where the original manuscripts were ever in one book. So the originals, nobody has ever had them. Nobody has ever read them. All you have in the Greek and Hebrew manuscripts that you have are copies that are what? Six, 700 years old, than they were the originals were wrote? Nobody has ever had them. Nobody ever really has read them.

In fact, what do you do with this, doctor? In Jeremiah, the book of Jeremiah, Jeremiah writes the book of Jeremiah. In [Jeremiah 36], that is the original Jeremiah. In [Jeremiah 36], one of your buddies, Dr. Jehudi, picks up the book of Jeremiah, does not like what he reads in it. So he does what you scribes and Pharisees do. He takes out his penknife, and he cuts out the passages that he does not like and throws them in a fire. The problem is he did not like any of it, but at the time he is done, the first set of originals of Jeremiah were all put into the fire. Then in [Jeremiah 36:32], there is a second set of originals of the book of Jeremiah. How do you explain that? That one gets destroyed, and lo and behold, in [Jeremiah 51:61], another set of originals of Jeremiah gets penned by the hand of Jeremiah. The Bible tells you in [Jeremiah 36:32] that none of them matched word for word. He added words to every original, and now you have three sets of originals. You have to be absolutely either brain dead or demon possessed to buy into their teaching.

The originals, all of the 66 of them, were never in any collection of a book. So when you say the Word of God is only perfect and inspired in the originals, that is the real Bible. You are talking about something that no one has ever seen in 6,000 years, it never existed. Nobody has ever read it. Nobody could ever get their hands on it. It is a figment of your imagination because this mythical, magical, mystical Bible that you say is perfect, could not be found anywhere in 6,000 years of man's history. Do you think Paul had the originals of Moses? Do you really? Do you think he had the original copy of Isaiah? Do you really? Did he give you the original copy of his book? If he did, he would give you the original copy of his book. They called what you paid over probably \$100,000 and spent, what, five or six years? They call that higher education. You have to get your money back.

The Bible says the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us. Four ways that you know your King James Bible is superior to the originals. Any day, any place, anywhere, any time. Four ways your King James, 1611, Authorized Version, the perfect, inspired, preserved, complete, Word of God without error. Four ways that is superior to Dr. Fine, Dr. Howard, Dr. Fine.

1. The AV is superior to the originals because you can read the AV-1611, and no one has ever, ever, ever, ever, in the history of the world read the originals.
2. The AV-1611 is superior to the originals because at least, at least 200 billion people have come to a saving knowledge through a King James 1611 Authorized Version. There is not one person in heaven, earth, outer space, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, that ever came to Christ with the original manuscripts.
3. The third thing we have already talked about, the Bible means books. There never was a time in the history of the world when the original manuscripts were ever in one book. So that

Bible, that fable Bible, that pretense Bible like your pretense life, like your pretense ministry is a figment of your imagination.

4. The fourth thing, [2 Timothy 3:16] says, 2 Timothy 3:16

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: The original manuscripts were never scripture. In the Bible, the word "scripture" is not used for scripture till it is in a written book, and it tells you that all scripture is given by inspiration. So you have a Bible in your hand that is scripture that was given by inspiration, and the original manuscripts were never scriptures. The scriptures here are profitable for doctrine. The originals are not. It is profitable for reproof. The originals were not. It is profitable for correction. The originals cannot, and it is profitable for instruction in righteousness. The originals are not. It also perfects you. How do you get perfected by the scriptures if the scriptures do not exist? Only in the minds of the Sadducees, the Pharisees, and the corrupt scribes today, which we know and love as our Bible scholars. How do you get perfected? Then at the same time, it says there are furnishings that the Word of God puts into your life. How do you get perfected for the work of the ministry and get the furnishings that you need in your life if the Bible does not exist except in the figment of minds of scholarship and original manuscripts that never existed in a book, therefore it never was a Bible. Therefore you do not have it.

The answer to that? The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us. God translated Him from heaven to here, one place to the other. Then when God translated Him back, He gave you the written Word of God, a King James 1611 Authorized Version, which now we know is the mind of God, the mind of Christ, and you are to arm yourself with that mind. Those are the inspired scriptures. Now if that is not superior, then you are out of your mind.

Right now you have a perfect book that is God's mind. You have the Holy Spirit of God inside you, Christ in you, the hope of glory, [Colossians 1:27]. The church right now is called the body of Christ, not this building, you. You should know now that there are two adoptions in the Bible in [Romans 8]. When you got saved, you were spiritually adopted, that is your soul, He lives inside you, the kingdom of God that you were translated from darkness into that kingdom. It is inside you, and then there is coming a day when you get your physical adoption and you get Christ's glorified body.

I showed you yesterday in Bible Institute how there is coming a day, [Hebrews 8], when there will be no more preaching. In the millennium, there will be no more people preaching, there will be no more passing out tracts, and no more people getting saved like we do in the church age. There will also be no more Bible, and I showed you that clearly from the Old Testament passage based on [Hebrews 8] yesterday in Institute, no question about it. In the millennium, all those things cease.

Now I know, I know, I know. So many of God's people, you are so shallow when it comes to the Bible, you have an IQ below sub-plant life. I get that. But I am telling you right now, you think that all through history of the Old Testament now and on into a millennium and on into that, people are trusting Jesus Christ as their own personal Savior. I showed you yesterday how that is completely false heresy and not true. The reason why there is no preaching and nobody going

around like you do right now saying, "Do you know the Lord? Do you know the Lord? Do you know the Lord?" It is because the Bible says in [Hebrews 8] that everybody will know who He is because He is sitting on the throne in Jerusalem, and the whole world knows who He is. The reason why there will be no Bible? Oh, here it comes. The reason why there will be no King James Bible in the millennium? Oh, here it comes. You will be the Bible.

Right now you have the Holy Spirit of God, which is the Word of God inside you, and God gave you His mind in a book, but when you get the glorified body of Christ, you do not need the book anymore, and now you are the walking, talking person of Jesus Christ, and you are the incarnate Word of God. The mind of Christ translated to you in a book, not from one language to another, but from one place to another. When you got saved, spiritually circumcised, when you got moved from translated from the kingdom of darkness to the kingdom of light, then you got the mind of Christ in the Word of God. Through that mind, you get that salvation, [Romans 12], by the renewing of your mind, and then after you get saved, you go through [1 John], Gospel of John, then you get conformed to His death. As salvation, you get transformed through your walk with God, you get conformed under the death, His death on a cross.

Your Bible is the complete, perfect, inspired Word of God, preserved for you by the Holy Spirit of God to be God's translation to you in this church age. I mean, come on, let us just try to get a little common sense here. I know common sense is not too common today, especially in churches, but what good is the fact, I mean, honestly, this asks us an honest question, what good is the fact that God inspired something somewhere if He was not God enough to preserve it to get it to you? You think I care that God was God enough to inspire, but He was not God enough to preserve it? I mean, come on, I mean, the Bible says that Jesus Christ is the incarnate Word of God, the Word was made flesh and God among us. Do you not agree that God brought Him through sinners? You think Mary was the Queen of Heaven like the Catholic Church teaches? You think she was sinless? You think God had to find a sinless woman to bring forth a sinless Son of God? No. The only thing holy about Mary was her socks. Yeah, I like that joke too, it went over big in the sixth grade when you are dealing with junior high kids, you obviously are much more sophisticated about it. She was not holy. You know what Mary said? She says, "I rejoice in God my Savior." She was as big a sinner as you are because I am.

You do not have a problem with the fact that God could bring the incarnate Word, the Son of God, down into this world through a sinner named Mary, live in a sinful world, grow up in a sinful world with sinful brothers and sisters, sinful moms and dads, and yet God preserved Him that He never got tainted with sin. You have a problem with that, do you? You defy, you defend that, that is the virgin birth, oh that is the sinless Son of God. You are all over that, but let me tell you something, you have a problem with the fact that He can, God could bring the sinless incarnate Word through a sinner and bring Him down through history and keep Him perfect, but He could not do it with the Word of God. How stupid you are? How stupid you are? You say you should not use the word stupid, that is better. I do not like the word stupid, but I like using it for you because you are stupid. You are one of the most stupid people standing up and teaching the Bible today and telling God's people that they do not have the absolute truth of the Word of God, that they have to go to you, they have to go to the Greek Hebrew lexicon, or they have to go to a

Greek New Testament, you have to learn Greek in Hebrew so you can have a relationship with God. Are you kidding me?

I will be honest, the only people stupider than you are the people that are in your church listening to you this morning. Some guy came in here and tried to, it was a guy in the church here several years ago, they got up there, that church used to believe the King James Bible, do not believe it anymore, and they get up and he was such a radical rebel, demon possessed, whatever, he waved his NIV and he says, "I want everybody to know that I am NIV positive this morning," and everybody cheered and clapped, and he said, "Well, let me tell you something, if the judgment seat of Christ or wherever you show up, you would be much better shaped with HIV than you will be with your NIV." But that is just the rantings of a radical foaming at the mouth guy. You know, when you have to preach, you have to use a little props. My mouth is a little dry this morning. I am not foaming like I normally do, but I am working on it.

I mean, if He was God enough to inspire, He is God enough to preserve it because they are one in the same. I mean, did you ever see this? I mean, we are just down in the simple basics today. Did you ever see this, the Bible and Christ and what they have in common because they are one and the same?

5. They both have two natures. Christ was the Son of Man, yet He was the Son of God. The Bible is a history book, yet it is the book of God and God's holiness.
6. They are both hated.
7. They both were loved.
8. They both can save you.
9. They both can damn you.
10. They are both eternal.
11. They are both alive.
12. They are both going to judge you.
13. Both of them, this book and God, bear the marks and the scars of unsaved men who hated them and tried to destroy them, one on the cross, one in your Bible colleges or your pulpit this morning.

III. He Dwelt Among Us

Now that was the first thing. Now the second thing I want you to see this, "And the Word was made flesh and dwelt among us." You would not think much of that little word "dwelt" there. You just blow right through that and would not even think much about it. Of course, that is the way most people do, they do not pay attention to every word in the Bible, but this is one of the greatest studies in all of the Bible just on that little word "dwelt."

The word "dwelt" is where we get our word "dwelling," and we all have a dwelling we go to unless you are homeless, and then you are dwelling-less, but it is the same system. But it is the thing where the Bible says that He dwelt among us. We saw yesterday in the book of in Bible Institute what a great time we had about in [Hebrews 8] the patterns, how God does everything by pattern. We talked a lot about the tabernacle and the holy of holies, and that was a pattern, and

you will find that in [Exodus 25] and [Exodus 26], and then [Leviticus 23] and [Leviticus 24] will add you some more information to that. I tried to tell you and show you that the ark and the tabernacle is a type of Christ. There are three parts to it, just like there is the Godhead, and wherever you went or Israel went in the Old Testament on their journey, that ark in the tabernacle went before them, and they followed it. It was a, it was a thing where it was the center of everything that they did. I told you Thursday about the three families that took care of that, and they were right there with it when they camped, and then you had the 12 tribes in order around it, and then you had the mixed multitude that were out in the outer fringe, just like any church. Any church will have families in it that are dialed into that ark and that covenant and that tabernacle, and brother, they minister. Then you will have people in a circle out there that come to church but they do not really get involved. Then you have the people that are the fringe people that all they do is complain about everything. It is the same system, the same system.

Now along with that ark in the nation of Israel, there were seven Old Testament feasts. Seven Old Testament feasts. They are found in [Leviticus 23] and [Leviticus 24]. One of those feasts was the Feast of Tabernacles. I have told you before that the Feast of Tabernacles is probably the greatest single feast in the Bible to study. It is the beginning of the creation in [Genesis 1]. It was in September, October, Feast of Tabernacles. It was the time of the first coming of Christ, and it will be the time of the second coming of Christ, and that is, there is no question about that. The Feast of Tabernacles is a picture of Christ coming to this earth at the first coming and the second coming to dwell with man, to be dwelling in man, the tabernacle among us, dwelt among us. The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us. The Word was made flesh and tabernacled among us. It is called the Feast of Tabernacles because during that feast they all made little huts, little booths, they all made little dwellings, and they stayed in these dwellings for seven days. The roof of these dwellings were palm leaves, and the significance of that Feast of Tabernacles was a picture that they dwelt in those little booths for seven days during the Feast of Tabernacles. They built a little tabernacle because it was a picture of the day that God would come down and tabernacle among men. When Jesus goes into Jerusalem over there in [John 12] and [Mark 11] on His triumphal entry, you know what they do? They put down on the road palm leaves because palm leaves always represent the millennial reign of Christ. So in the Feast of Tabernacles, they made the roof out of palm leaves because it was looking for when He came back and tabernacled among men, dwelt among us. The Word was made flesh and dwelt, tabernacled among us. That is what they are looking for. Now we know that it got postponed at the first coming of Christ, church age comes in, but it is going to happen in the second coming.

Now let us look at these feasts for a moment. These seven feasts will run the course of seven months, and they are an incredible study, and they are laid out over a seven-month period because these seven feasts represent the 7,000 years that God is going to be dealing with man, 6,000 here, the 7,000 the millennium. So what you have here is you have the first three feasts will take place in the first month, and it will be the Feast of Passover, then it will be the Feast of Unleavened Bread, and then it will be the Feast of Firstfruits. It is where the gay and the lesbians get in. It is a thing where these three feasts are all take place in the first month, and this will represent the Old Testament from Exodus where they come out of Egypt at the Passover up to

Malachi, and the Passover, Unleavened Bread, and the Firstfruits run from the Old Testament to Exodus up to the end of the Old Testament in Malachi.

Then you have the second month, which is called the Feast of Weeks, and this runs 49 days. This will represent the 400 years of Israel's captivity at the end of the Old Testament, and that 400 years before Christ shows up, that will be your second month. On the third month, you have the Feast of Pentecost, and that will represent the first coming of the Lord Jesus Christ and the coming of the Holy Spirit of God. That will be the third month.

Then you will have the fourth month, the fifth month, and the sixth month where there are no feasts, and the reason why there are no feasts because this represents the church age, and [Colossians 2] tells us that during the church age there is no feast, there is no holy days, there is no moons, there is no Sabbath. So now in the after the after the after the third month, first coming of Christ, you have the fourth, fifth, and sixth month where there is no, there is no feast, and that represents the church age.

Then you have the last month or the seventh month, and in that you have the last three feasts. Here it comes, you notice I have not went to the Greek or the Hebrew one time yet. I got this out of a King James 1611 Authorized Version, guy go into the English. So you had the first month, the second month, the third month, the fourth, fifth, and sixth month, and now you come to the seventh month, and the seventh month there are the three last feasts.

14. The first one is the Feast of Trumpets, that will be the regathering of the nation of Israel in 1917, 1948.
15. The next one will be the Feast of Atonement, that will be the Jews making an atonement for killing Christ in the tribulation period. Here it comes.
16. The last one will be the Feast of Tabernacles, which represents the second coming of Christ and God coming back to dwell and tabernacle among men forever.

You could not figure that out with a Greek and a Hebrew if your life depended on it, and that is why, sir, if I may say, you are so boring in your preaching. That is why, might I say that in Bible colleges, when you teach these young preachers about the Bible or building churches or soul winning, you are like a one-legged man teaching Olympic running. Now you begin to see how the Bible will lay itself out. That book is the most incredible book you will ever see. It is God's perfect Word.

In 1900, while the Southern Baptist Convention was buying into the RSV from Westcott and Hort, the most corrupt two demon-possessed guys that ever walked this planet, that ever corrected your Bible, and the whole Southern Baptist Convention had now thrown out the King James Bible and took on the RSV, and it just spread through all of the Baptists except the Bible believers, the remnant like you here today. In 1900, a guy by the name of Dr. William Lloyd Phelps, he wrote a book. It was a simple little book for a man with his intelligence. It was simply called *Reading the Bible*. In fact, my first book that I wrote many, many years ago that deals with understanding the Bible, you know, keys to the Bible, I did that based on reading his book and was inspired by how simple his stuff was. So I wrote a book, my first book, *How to Study the Bible*. It was based on Dr. Lloyd's book. I mean, I did not take his material, his material was

completely different, but the idea behind it in its simplicity, and it was published by Macmillan House in New York in 1919, and on pages 10, 12, and 13, here is what he said. He said in the middle of all of Christianity dumping it for an RSV, which came out of Sinaiticus and Vaticanus out of the Roman Catholic Church, the most corrupt, demon-possessed, godless piece of trash that ever graced this planet, he said the King James 1611 is the most important and influential book in English literature. No English in all the world is equal to that which is found in the King James 1611 Authorized Version. Whether the originals were inspired or not, I have never had any doubt in the divine inspiration of the King James 1611 Authorized Version. You say, "Who was he?" Oh, he was nobody. He was a senior professor at Yale University on English Literature, that is who he was.

IV. We Beheld His Glory

Now the third thing, "and we beheld his glory." Last week we talked about four things that declare God's glory: Christ, the Word of God, you and me, and the heavens, and they are all connected. Christ was the incarnate Word. The Word of God was the inspired Word, God's mind. You and me got it when we got saved, and the Bible says the heavens were made by those same words. Today we see God's glory in the church age in your life and my life, but only through the mind of Christ, the Word of God, the incarnate Word, Christ, and the written Word, the Word of God, Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Just as man took my perfect Savior, the leaders of Israel, the Son of God, and beat Him and scarred Him and whipped Him, so the leaders of the church today, our scribes and Pharisees and Sadducees, will do the same thing with the written Word of God, my perfect book. Cut it up, change it up, mar it, and marry it to the things of this world like Constantine did in 400 AD. John said, "and we beheld his glory." In both cases, God's perfect translation, we beheld the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ, and we beheld the glory when the when the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, we beheld His glory. If you have a King James Bible in your lap this morning or you are listening to me on here and you have a King James Bible, and you look into it, every time you look into it, you are beholding God's glory, the mind of Christ.

John wrote in [1 John 5:7],

1 John 5:7

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

Now it is no great thing that you should be surprised that that verse is only found in a King James 1611 Authorized Version. It should be no surprise that whatever other Greek manuscript you find, Sinaiticus, Nestle's Greek Text, Alford, whatever you find, that verse will be missing in that text. The only Greek text that has that verse in it is the Stephanus text out of Antioch, the Textus Receptus that your King James Bible came from, and the only translation on this planet today that has that verse in it, and you may find it in there, but there will be a footnote that tells you that it does not belong in there, so King James 1611.

Now why would somebody want to take that verse out? I will tell you why it is. John said in [1 John 1:1],

1 John 1:1

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon, and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

"That which was from the beginning," that is God. In the beginning, God. In the beginning was God, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. John says in the beginning that which was in the beginning, Jesus Christ, he says He is here now, He has been translated from heaven to here, and we have heard Him, we have seen Him, and our hands have handled the Word of life, and we beheld His glory. It is true in both. John looked at the sinless Son of God who was the manifestation of the Word of God and beheld His glory. You have the incarnate Word, which is His mind. We could both hear it, see it, read it, and hold it.

V. The Only Begotten of the Father, Full of Grace and Truth

Now the fourth thing, lastly here, we are in good shape here. The fourth thing, "the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." I want to talk about for a moment the word "begotten." The word "begotten" means first one, first in a series, first of a kind. Jesus Christ was the first begotten Son that in time would lead to you and I becoming His Son through a new birth, but He is the first one. He was the first in the series of sons of God. You and I followed in the series, but He is number one. He was the begotten. He was the only begotten of the Father, and He is the one that was the first one that was begotten, and then through Him and the Word of God, you and I get translated into being a son of God just like Him, but He is the model, He is the type, He is the example of God of what God wants to transform and to conform us in our life under His death. He wants to transform you the day you get saved, but then you get into the book, you let people help you and you grow, and then He conforms you all to His mind.

You know, I preached just a while back, you got 2020, the year 2020 is most definitely probably the end of life as we know it or once knew it on planet Earth. I am going to tell you right now, you are going to need the mind of Christ in your life more than ever before. Tuesday is Election Day, and I do not care, I am not a political guy one way or the other, but I am going to tell you right now, if this country goes the way it looked like it is going to go, and the liberal take over this country from a formalized standpoint of becoming the leaders of this country, and sooner or later they are going to, you know, if we get a reprieve for another four years of a conservative being in there, it is still going to build all around us.

You know, I have watched this thing, and maybe you do not see things like this, but I have watched this thing over the years all the way back from the 1960s. You know, back in the 60s, John F. Kennedy was president, and he was a Democrat. The Democrats back then were more conservative and on the right side of things than they could ever hope to be today. What you have seen, if you are paying attention, remember now, America dumped the Bible in 1900 thereabouts, and what you have watched now is over 120 some years, every cycle of elections, this thing deteriorates more toward the radical ungodly left that wants to bring in every piece of filth into

this country and destroy the very values that many of you and our country was built on, and it is going, it has got to happen sooner or later. I mean, it is going to happen sooner or later, and Election Day, it may go just like that, or it may get a reprieve for another four years, but it is going to happen sooner or later, and I am telling you right now, you better understand that there is coming a day when the only friend you are going to have is the Bible you have in your lap today and whatever personal relationship you have with Christ. There is no stopping it. We may delay it, but even then it is going to be filling up and building all around us.

I watched it in the 60s, I watched it in the 70s, I watched it in the 80s, I watched it in the 90s. I watched it begin to creep in where we were formed originally. We were formed as a republic, and then somewhere along the line we changed through a democracy, and where a republic is built on the principles of an unchanging Word of God that the founding fathers wanted, somewhere along the line we changed from that, and then we became a democracy, and where in a republic the rule of law follows the rule of God, in a democracy whoever has got more votes is who rules. Now it is changing from a democracy, listen to me now, it is going to change, if not this year, in the years to come, you are going to see it, your kids are going to grow up in it. Now it is going to go from a republic to a democracy to a socialistic government. It is going to become like Venezuela, it is going to become like Cuba, and in time, and I do not care what any political analyst says, look at history, the Soviet Union is ranked communist today, but I want you to know when Lenin and Trotsky and those guys started out, they were all socialists. It will not stop with that, and I am telling you right now, this country sooner or later will become a socialist country, and then sooner or later it is going to go communist because you can see it every election, it gets a narrow margin of the good people versus the bad people, and it comes at a place where what happens is it is only going to be a matter of time before the scales get tipped that there are more bad people that are going to vote than there are good people who are going to, they are going to overwhelm the good people, and that is the way it is going to go, and life on planet Earth as you know it, as you once knew it, no longer going to be.

They are saying now the coronavirus is going to probably go all the way to the end of 2022. There is no end to that. There is no, there is no fast track vaccine coming, and they are already, I am not a conspiracy theory guy, I am not, I am not, I go to the Bible, I do not have any conspiracy theory, I just can read my Bible. I know in a socialistic country, in a communist country, they tell you where you can go and where you cannot go, and right now you are so stupid you do not even see it. They are telling you you have to wear a mask, and they are telling you when you have to go to a grocery store, you can go down this aisle this way, when you have to go down the other aisle that way. There is going to come a day when they are going to strip every freedom from you that you have, and I am telling you all you are going to have will be the Bible you have in your lap right now. There is coming a day, and you can mark my words, there is coming a day when you are not going to have a church, you are not going to have your Christian friends, you are not going to have me, all you are going to have is that book.

I mean, come on, can we talk real? You are kidding me if God's people today will get mad and leave their church over something as stupid as COVID-19 today, what do you think will happen when they come after you for believing the book that you have got? What do you think is going

to happen when they label this church and all the other Bible believing churches as racist churches? What are you going to do when they make this church register like they did in Romania, like they did in all the communist countries and the socialistic companies that they can monitor what you say because it is going to become controlled that you can only say what they want you to say, and now preaching about gays, preaching about lesbians, preaching about this, preaching about that becomes an offensive thing and becomes a racial, a racial issue, just like if somebody got up and and and preach racial messages today, and this church and everybody in it at work, at school, with your friends, in your neighborhood, you are going to be splattered across the nine o'clock, six o'clock, five o'clock news because now you are going to be the odd man out. That is the way that it is going. It is the way that it is headed, and God's people get their noses bent out of joint over something as stupid as a virus, and I am not taking it away, they are serious or something, but where do you see what is coming? If you cannot stand now, do not tell me when they start knocking on your door, do not tell me when your boss comes up and says, "You cannot work here anymore because you have gone to that church." Do not tell me when they are standing outside and you are walking out of here and they have got their signs that we are racist, you are a racist. You cannot stand in the face of something else that is so significant to what is coming. Are you kidding me?

Right now as a remnant, all we have is each other, but I am telling you, there is a day coming when you will not have that. All you will have is the book in your lap, and the only mind you will have is the one that God gave you that is His mind, and you know what, learn from history, they will probably take that from you, and that is why, and I know, do not listen to me, that is why the Bible says, "Let the Word of Christ dwell in you richly." You ought to be memorizing whole pages and books of that Bible. You ought to know more than just [John 3:16], for there is coming a day most likely that the only Bible you will have to hold on to is what you have hid in your heart.
